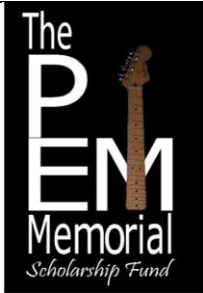

## The P.E.M. Memorial Scholarship

The Preston. Eckerle. Morrison. (P.E.M.) Memorial Scholarship is now accepting applications from Finneytown High School seniors who plan to pursue a degree in the arts or music at an accredited university or college.

The P.E.M. Memorial Scholarship was founded in August 2010 out of love for the Finneytown students who lost their lives at the Who Concert in Cincinnati on December 3<sup>rd</sup> 1979. **Stephan Preston** ('79), **Jackie Eckerle** ('82), and **Karen Morrison** ('82) each had a passion for the arts and music. The scholarship founders, **John Hutchins** ('80), **Steve Bentz** ('80), and **Fred Wittenbaum** ('83), thought it fitting that the scholarships help students at Finneytown to realize their dreams in arts and music creating the mission: "Preserving 3 Memories ... Building 3 Dreams".

Three scholarships are awarded each year, and this year, the committee is pleased to raise the one-time scholarship amount to \$2500 per student. Guidelines and applications for the scholarships can be obtained from the Guidance Counselors office at the high school or at [www.pemmemorial.org](http://www.pemmemorial.org). Applications are due on April 1, 2013 and will be awarded at Senior Awards Night in May.

Some general guidelines for students interested in applying include:

- Major or minor in the field of Arts or Music with any relation to these disciplines. The arts can include fine arts, performing arts, literary arts, and culinary arts.
- Acceptance at an accredited degree granting institution. Evidence of enrollment is required.
- Full-time and part-time studies are both eligible for consideration.
